You <u>must</u> state your losses, since you cannot get a refund otherwise. Refunds are determined by subtracting US losses, for the entire year, from the total annual winnings and computing tax on the difference.

Gambling losses can be proved with statements from the casino, ATM withdrawals at the casinos, and cancelled checks for cash at the casinos. A diary of winnings and losses with date, game, name of casino, and names of other present is also adequate. Winnings from blackjack, baccarat, craps, roulette, big-6 wheel, and pari-mutuel dog & horse racing are not taxable when won by a non-US person. We do not need to see this information, but you should keep it for at least 6 years, since the IRS has the right to audit returns and request proof of losses after a refund has been issued.
